Boys as Babes, sports heroes  
Little Bo Peep, Robin Hood  
Colorful personalities locally  
Paris Hilton/Elvis/ Shrek  
Saints, politicians  
Song titles  
Corny musicians  
Witches/ pirates/ gypsy  
Square dancing couple  
Child size  
Bride and groom  
Advertising your business  
Nickname on hat  
Tropical dancer, Indian  
Hippy or flower child  
On tractor/ bike  
Moving parts like wind chimes  
Feeding birds  
Clay pot upside down on bird  
bath for body  
Doing cartwheel, stilt walker  
Tin man (spray plastic)  
Tea party or cards  
Gardner with rake,  
wheelbarrow, etc.  
Warrior/ fireman  
Butterfly catcher or fishing

## Hand Expressions:

On hips, waving  
Over heart  
On mouth  
Folded  
Listening  
Holding hat, binoculars  
Holding instrument, etc.  
Taking an oath  
Stop!

## Accessories:

Ties, belts, purse  
Earrings, necklaces  
Tennis racket, guitar  
Could use signs for scarecrow  
statements or title/name  
Don't use anything valuable in  
case it gets lost or damaged  
Skirt of leaves or soda bottles

## SCARECROW IDEAS

### Heads:

Gourds with goggles, glasses  
Pumpkin with stem for nose  
Skillet or paddle  
Frizbee, tennis racket  
Paper Mache or plastic plate  
Pillow case tied on stick at neck  
Mop head with rock star glasses  
Cut off pants, legs tied on ends  
Ferns in pot with face on it  
Milk jugs (1/2 or 1 gal.)  
Paint can, lamp shade  
2 liter bottle, etc., on stick  
Broom or rake, shovel  
Bucket/ plastic plant pot  
Basket or shoebox  
Paint face with permanent  
markers (cartoons for ideas)  
Panty part of nylon hose  
Asleep with hat over  
Styrofoam tray

### Hair:

Leaves, pine cones  
Wreath, headband  
Pony tails, bandanna  
Fabric, felt or plastic strips  
Yarn/ twine braids  
Raffia (straw)  
Mop, brush

### Hats:

Magician, baseball cap  
Southern belle  
Bonnet, shower cap  
Crown, wreath  
Stocking cap, cowboy

### Hands: (optional)

Ear of corn with shucks  
Gloves (work, fancy long,  
Playtex, hospital, garden)  
Bows for holding something  
Branches, socks, oven mitt

### Shoes:

Roller skates, skis  
High heels, flip flops

### Boots, sneakers

Stuff legs or socks so they fit  
snugly (pin socks to pants?)  
Tin cans, plastic cups, scrub  
brush or hairbrush, Pringles can  
Toe socks, booties, slippers  
Big pine cones or rolled up  
newspaper

Stuffing: start saving early!!!  
none if gingerbread style (flat)  
Paper/ plastic bags/ straw  
Quilt batting or white material  
in panty hose that will show  
Shredded paper

### Support:

None if sitting droopy style  
Welded metal scraps, rebar  
Chair or hay bale to lean on  
Weighted bucket to sit on  
Plumbing leftovers  
T or TT for 1 or 2 figures  
(can join with screws if  
holding hands or do arms  
around each other)  
stake could be stuck into a  
hay bale or huge flower pot  
full of dirt  
X for cartwheel?  
Clothes hanger taped to pole  
Box, broom handle

### Ears, Eyes, Nose

Eggshell half (or plastic)  
Flowers, gourds, acorns  
Pods, corn, pine  
cones  
Seed heads, spools, fabric  
Junk hardware or long lasting  
veggies on a pumpkin

### Clothing:

Shorts over leggings  
Burlap sacks with holes cut  
T-shirts cut into tunics, vest  
with fringes  
Grandma's closet or Goodwill
