

The St. Joseph Scrip Program

What is Scrip?

Scrip is a program that includes local businesses working with our St. Joseph Family to help raise money to better educate our children.

How does Scrip generate revenue for St. Joseph Catholic School, Westphalia?

- We purchase large amounts of scrip (gift certificates) from grocery stores, department stores, restaurants, and other retailers. The scrip is purchased with cash up front; the participating retailers offer a substantial discount to the school.
- We resell the scrip for full face value.
- The discount, 1% - 20%, is retained by our school as revenue.
- Twenty-five percent of the profit earned on your scrip purchases made between May 1, 2010, and April 30, 2011, may be credited to a family of your choice to pay 2011-2012 sustaining fees.

Retailers like scrip too!

Families who purchase scrip certificates actively support the retailers who participate in the program. The reason is simple; they know that buying from a scrip participating retailer provides a steady source of revenue for their church, school, or non-profit organization.

How Can I Purchase Scrip Cards?

- You can now email your order to stjoescrip@stjo1835.org. Your order will be sent home as soon as your check is received.
- By internet – www.shopwithscrip.com (enrollment # 48AD813A4876). Your order will be sent to you as soon as the payment is received.
- Use this scrip form. Scrip dates are listed below. Or, you can send the form to school along with your check and orders will be sent home (typically in 1 to 2 days) or you can pick up your scrip cards at Church (please mark on this on the form). REMINDER: Orders that are sent to school must arrive in the school office by noon on FRIDAY.
